Terms and Conditions

- User Responsibility for Accuracy: Users must ensure that all personal, debit/credit card, and bank account details provided are correct and accurate. Using a payment method that is not lawfully owned or authorized by the owner is prohibited.

- **Refund/Cancellation Policy:** This is a critical clause. Most policies state that once a fee is paid online, the transaction cannot be cancelled, and the amount is non-refundable, except in specific cases like multiple debits for a single transaction or a technical issue where payment is deducted but not reflected. Any refunds, if applicable, are handled according to the institution's internal policies and may take several working days.
- Governing Law and Jurisdiction: Any disputes arising from the use of the service will typically be governed by the laws and courts of a specific jurisdiction mentioned in the terms.
- Acceptance of Terms: By using the online payment facility, the user is deemed to have accepted all the terms and conditions.
